IRF Newsletter

The IRF Newsletter has been published since the IRF was formed in 1989, and is an important medium of communication within IRF Council and between all other rogainers. It is publicly available on the rogaining.org website. Whereas the monthly IRF Executive Roles & Responsibilities summary aims to report short to medium term activities of the IRF, the Newsletter focuses more on longer term issues including those of some historic importance.

The Newsletter is used for promotion of forthcoming rogaining events, reports of completed international rogaining championships, and records the history of rogaining and the IRF by capturing news of major decisions and activities as they happen. A number of Newsletters are dedicated to the organisation of rogaining internationally as a record of how things have been done for those who take leadership positions in future. The Newsletter has been issued approximately eight times per year by the President from submitted reports and forthcoming event details.
